Surveys will include, but are not limited to: mist-netting and acoustic monitoring. Roost surveys may also be conducted when appropriate. Perform other duties as assigned, such as data entry and equipment maintenance.

Work nights, irregular hours, and camp in remote areas for up to 8 Days Safely drive a 4-wheel drive vehicle and ATV

Routinely drive long hours, wade through water, and sit in the dark on cold nights
